I am running for election to serve in the Kentucky House of Representatives, representing District 66. I was honored to have held this seat from 2019-2022, serving two terms, but I was unfortunately defeated in the May 2022 primary. It was an off-year election and Boone County had a low voter turnout, resulting in only 10% of citizens voting. Unfortunately, I was not the only representative from Northern Kentucky to be defeated. Both former Representative Sal Santoro (District 60) and former Representative Adam Koenig (District 69) lost as well, resulting in Northern Kentucky losing 3 Chairmen that day. We were replaced by inexperienced Republican opposition who have failed to accomplish any objectives for Northern Kentuckians. The local party worked against us. It may be better said that the "Republican Party" cannibalized its own. In truth it is a group of Libertarians who cannot get elected unless they use the Republican moniker for both personal and political gain.

With that being said, I refuse to give up and accept defeat, so I am doing everything in my power to return and serve the people of District 66 in Frankfort. However, I can't do this alone. I need your help! This election will not be easy and will require money, volunteers, and many hours of hard work and dedication. 
I am committed to both civility and working across party lines and agencies to better benefit my constituents of District 66.
